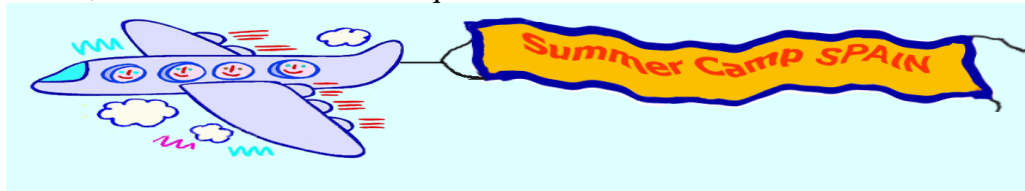

Younger learners develop their receptive skills much faster than their productive skills. This is important to keep in mind, if we are creating the basis for a more profound study of the language in the future. Our approach encourages spontaneous language production; it helps kids develop the ability to use the language in a proper and meaningful context, much in the same way that they learn their own language.
